Project Information

Describe your project idea (300).

Choose the type of infrastructure this project best fits with. You'll check all that apply from a list including:

- green infrastructure; water infrastructure; transportation; streetscape; facility/architecture; park, path, or trail; school; garden; other

List members of your project team as well as partners and indicate if they are potential or committed (3000).

Have you already engaged an artist(s) for this project?

If yes, you'll include the artist(s) name(s) and website(s), and talk about their role (6000).

If no, you can indicate that you need guidance from the Council or another agency in identifying a suitable artist.

Address the following (6000):

- Describe the project in which you would like to integrate public art
- List your goals and describe the change you'd like to see in your community as a result of this project
- Describe the planning to date including the timeline and qualifications of the leadership involved
- Describe unique attributes or history about your community that might be reflected in the artistic process or product
- Tell why this project is important to your community at this time

Include up to four images of the community, potential project location(s), and other visuals that help identify project potential for artist involvement.

The same information will be needed for additional project ideas submitted. Applicants may submit up to three project ideas.
